Soil profile The vineyards in which this wine grows offer an ideal terroir for distinctive lower Austrian varieties such as Blauburger and Blauer Portugieser. Here, the loess soil shows a great amount of chalk.

This is beneficial for the develop-ment of wines with crystal-clear fruit aroma. This blend grows on a southern slope, 300 metres

above sea level.

Tasting Notes

This blend of the venerable varieties Blauer Portugieser and
Blauburger com-bines class and charm. Not only violet colour
that reminds one of sour cher-ries can be seen, but also tints of

red. As regards smell, this wine offers aro-mas of long-established varieties that should not fade into obscurity. A har-mony of cherries and black currant with a pleasant silkiness can be smelled. Slightly cooled, the Cuvée exquisite of the winery Waldschütz shows that these varieties should not be underestimated. On the contrary, this wine convinces with its fruitiness, lightness and freshness. It is pure joy to taste a glass of

this stylish wine and to remember the irresistible aroma of sour

cher-ries that is still present in the long finish.
