

Soil profile Like the Riesling Kamptal DAC and the Grüner Veltliner Kamptal

DAC, the Gelber Muskateller grows on the terraces of the Loischl vineyards, one of the highest vineyards in the Kamptal region. In addition to sandy tongues of granite and slate, there are also

blue-tinged rock reminiscences of the Zöbinger Permian.

Tasting Notes A brightly sparkling, radiant, noble yellow refreshes and delights

when poured into the glass. The bouquet of this Muskateller presents itself with fine musky notes. Besides aromas like nutmeg and citrus notes, there is also a hint of green apple. On the palate, this wine convinces with a discreet, finesse-rich variety. Not overwhelming, but rather slim, straight and lively, the Gelber Muskateller from the Weinhof Waldschütz convinces everyone

who is looking for a light glass of wine.
