Soil profile Roter Veltliner Ried Goldberg grows exclusively in the single vineyard Goldberg. The Goldberg is located on the northern end of the Wagram area in nearby the village Gösing am Wagram. The south-eastern faced hillside is very well known for the very typical Austrian cool climate stile. On an altitude between 280-315m we have a lot of Danube gravel in the ground with a slight layer of Loess on the top. Since the roots of the vines have to grow deep in the gravel to get water and nutrients, this wine brings a lot of minerality from the terroir.

Tasting Notes Already while looking at this glass of wine the play of colours is impressing. A nice yellow with gold tinting can be spotted. The legs, which disappear only hesitantly from the rim, presage a rich wine. As regards smell, this wine reminds one of dried meadow-herbs paired with spiciness and exotic aromas which remind one of lychee and papayas. The Ried Goldberg, Roter Veltliner of the winery Waldschütz is richly complex on the palate, with a very nice spicy palate. Well balanced acidity makes a lot of fun. Its high density is noticeable. A great wine with perfect storage potential!
